
Driving to Rainbow Stage inside Kildonan Park

The Rainbow Stage theatre is located inside Kildonan Park in Winnipeg, Manitoba.

The Rainbow Stage theatre is open from the middle of **May** until the beginning of **September**.

The park is free to enter to all guests.

You can enter the park from Main Street.



The road inside the park is called McKay Drive.

It is built in a loop shape and you can continue driving on the same road throughout the park. You can follow the road to be led back to the exit gate.

While driving through the park, you will pass a black building with fences and gardens on your left side.



Not too much later, you will pass by a children's play structure. It is also on your left side.





Rainbow Stage is located next to the Kildonan Park Pool and Playground, located on your left side.

There is a green sign outside the building identifying the Pool and Playground.



Next, you will see a building peeking through the trees on your left side shortly after passing the playground. That building is Rainbow Stage.



There is another route to enter the park on Armstrong Avenue. You can enter from the side entrance to the park there.
Turn right at the intersection of Armstrong Avenue and Scotia Street.







The Parking Lot at Rainbow Stage

Parking is free for all guests of the park.

There will be City of Winnipeg attendants stationed in the parking lot during Rainbow Stage productions. They will guide drivers to the best parking spot.

There are a limited number of accessible parking spots available.

Attendants can guide you to one of these parking spots. Please have your valid accessible parking tag visible.

Finding the Parking Lot

While driving on McKay Drive inside the park, you will see the theatre on your left side. Drive past the archway and pedestrian crossing to arrive at the parking lot.



Then you will see these signs – one green and one white – on your left side.



"Rainbow Stage Parking. Do not leave valuables in vehicles."

Enter the Parking Lot using this driveway.

During our performances, parking is arranged using a trick called *stacked parking*. This means that vehicles are parked very close together.

There is not enough room to remove your vehicle from the parking lot until the production is over and other guests have begun to exit.

This is the front entrance to Rainbow Stage.



This is the place you would pick up tickets that you have purchased in advance, or where to go if you want to buy tickets when you arrive.

Please Be Aware


Many patrons park nearby on Scotia Street for an easy exit post-show.

If you choose to park on the street, please watch for restrictions.

There are several "No Parking" and "No Stopping" signs on the road in front of and near the theatre.

Drop Off Points

There are two locations that allow for easy drop off for guests before you park your vehicle.
